## NEW DOCUMENTARY



Our latest documentary, premiering in December, takes viewers back to the origins of the Amana Colonies. Located about an hour and a half west of the Quad Cities, the Amana Colonies were founded by 'The Inspirationalists,' a religious group from Germany who, fleeing persecution, migrated to America in the mid-1800s to establish a communal society with a self-sufficient lifestyle, sharing resources and labor, all based on their faith and values.

The Amana Colonies, a group of seven historic villages in eastern Iowa, are renowned for their communal lifestyle, rich cultural heritage, and strong ties to religious beliefs.

The documentary features interviews with descendants still living in the Colonies, offering a look into the rich history of the people who worked together to sustain themselves in the heartland of the Midwest.

## NEW FROM PBS KIDS



**Carl the Collector**, is the first show featuring a lead character on the autism spectrum. The PBS KIDS series, beginning on Thursday, November 14 at 1:00PM, is a 2D animated series for children ages 4–8 that follows the everyday adventures of Carl, a warm-hearted autistic raccoon who enjoys collecting things and loves his friends and family in Fuzzytown.

Carl pays extraordinarily close attention to detail and comes up with unique ideas that others might not consider. These traits have helped him amass his extensive collections which can come in handy for solving problems around the neighborhood with his friends.

"Carl the Collector" values inclusion and empathy, while modeling relationship-building and social skill development, wrapped up in humor, heart, and incredible visual design," said Sara DeWitt, Senior Vice President and General Manager, PBS KIDS.
