

NEW DOCUMENTARY



Our latest documentary, premiering in December, takes viewers back to the origins of the Amana Colonies. Located about an hour and a half west of the Quad Cities, the Amana Colonies were founded by 'The Inspirationalists,' a religious group from Germany who, fleeing persecution, migrated to America in the mid-1800s to establish a communal society with a self-sufficient lifestyle, sharing resources and labor, all based on their faith and values.

The Amana Colonies, a group of seven historic villages in eastern lowa, are renowned for their communal lifestyle, rich cultural heritage, and strong ties to religious beliefs.

The documentary features interviews with descendants still living in the Colonies, offering a look into the rich history of the people who worked together to sustain themselves in the heartland of the Midwest.
