## Living in a Dumpster

Rents in London are among the highest in the world. When designer Harrison Marshall returned to the British capital after a few months abroad and started looking for a place to live, he was shocked at the astronomical prices, which were unaffordable on his salary. His solution: In January 2022, he moved into an old dumpster, which he gradually transformed into a stylish tiny house.

Marshall now lives rent-free in central London. His new home is hardly boutique accommodation: there is no running water and the toilet is outside. But with no prospect of moving any time soon, what started out as a temporary idea has now become a more permanent solution – and Marshall sees his 'Skip House' as a commentary on the state of the housing market in London.
